In a departure from doomsday predictions, this documentary explores the metaphysical reasons for modern humankind's fascination with apocalypse. Blavatsky provides a wonderful image of a universe infused with the purpose, harmony and beauty of light and life. Topics such as the One Absolute Reality, the three Logoi, the hierarchy of divine beings, and Fohat (cosmic/divine energy) as the bridge between archetypal ideas and cosmic existence, will be illustrated from Eastern And Western sacred traditions, including alchemy, kabala and hermeticism. Workshop to follow on Saturday "The Stanzas of Dzyan"</p> <hr/> <p>Saturday Nov 26 AN APPROACH TO STUDYING The Stanzas of Dzyan The Seven Stanzas in HP Blavatsky's <i>The Secret Doctrine</i> deal with the esoteric (divine and physical) processes and mechanisms occurring in the Universe as it cycles through periods of manifestation and rest. We all know that it is not an easy subject as HPB (its author) and her Masters used terms and imagery taken from India, China, Hermetic traditions, kabala, Pythagorean and Platonic traditions, among many others. At these sessions, we will learn to use several tools and techniques with the Stanzas themselves, so they will come to life like flowers in springtime revealing their wisdom. One of these tools is the Law of Analogy of Correspondence - the famous Hermitic axiom: As Above, So Below. This will be used extensively so the participant will learn how to use it in its fullness to draw similarities between the evolution of the Universe and the enfoldment of one's own life. This seminar/workshop will be fully illustrated and given in a sharing environment. Handouts will be provided. Martin Leiderman, an industrial engineer by profession, lectures widely in both English and Spanish internationally in the areas of theosophy, comparative symbology, and Eastern and Western philosophy.
