MARCH 5	SANSKRIT MANTRAS AND THE AVATARS OF VISHNU: AN INTRODUCTION Thomas Ashley-Farrand Chanting traditions span the centuries and are steeped in ritual and sacred ceremony. This is expressed in Christianity in the phrase "As ye sow, so shall ye reap." There are a number of different theories as to how the Law of Karma works. Dr. Brooks will discuss some of them and draw implications from them for the way we ought to live our lives.

To correct an imbalance or bring back balance in the body. Monica will present homeopathy as an all natural health practice for people of all ages.		
APRIL 2	BROTHERHOOD IS POSSIBLE – ONE PERSON AT A TIME Betty Bland, President of the Theosophical Society in America The first fundamental principle of Theosophy is that all human beings emanate from the one Source, and as such we are intimately connected in the single human family. We will explore ways that we can find peace within ourselves and promote harmony and peace among our fellow beings.		
APRIL 9	THE THREE CRUCIFIXIONS Parke Carrier Parke will cover the Biblical, Historical; the Astronomical, Astrological; and the Mystical, Personal aspects of life.		
APRIL 16	The Magical Religion of Asclepius, son of Apollo, the Sun Christine Mohr Christine will explore Spiritual Astrology as taught by Marsilio Ficino, 15 th century physician of the soul, who influenced Giordano Bruno's "Spaccio" and "De Imaginibus" compositions, originally to ease the religious antagonism of his time. APRIL 30	HOW TO MEDITATE USING CHAKRAS, MANTRAS & BREATH Dennis Chernin, M.D., M.P.H. We will explore the physical, emotional, mental and spiritual benefits of meditation. We will learn to use several objects of concentration including chakras (energy centers), mantras (subtle sound vibrations) yantras (geometric forms), light, and breath.
